

TITLE: Gatherings of Ten (10) or More People and Symptomatic Individuals on Port Property During COVID-19 Crisis
PROMULGATED BY THE CEO & PORT DIRECTOR ON: March 19, 2020
EFFECTIVE DATE: IMMEDIATELY UPON PROMULGATION
This Administrative Policy is effective upon approval by the CEO & Port Director pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 241.
SUPERSESSON:
This Policy is a new policy and does not supersede or conflict with existing policy.
PURPOSE:
To reduce regulate or prohibit gatherings of ten (10) or more people during the COVID-19 crisis and therefore help to prevent the spread of the virus.
POLICY:
<p>A. No organization conducting business on Port property may hold a gathering of ten (10) or more people on Port property without first having obtained the written permission of the CEO & Port Director at least thirty (30) days in advance of the gathering. The 30-day time period may be adjusted by the CEO & Port Director in her reasonable discretion.</p> <p>B. No person exhibiting any of the symptoms of COVID-19, including but not limited to a fever, may enter or remain upon Port property.</p> <p>This policy shall remain in effect for the duration of the COVID-19 crisis, as determined by the CEO & Port Director.</p>
RELATED POLICIES AND PROCEDURES:

DEFINITIONS:
“Gathering” for purposes of this policy shall mean and include any assembly, meeting, or event of any kind.
